Greater Lynn Mental Health and Retardation Association, which serves 17 area communities, has changed its name to Bridgewell, the agency announced yesterday.

The name is intended to “better reflect the work and the range of services the organization provides” by representing a bridge supporting people through many challenges and well for good health and situations, according to the agency.

Bridgewell is a private, nonprofit organization which a service area that includes Peabody, Danvers, Beverly, Swampscott and Salem. It serves more than 2,600 people a day with mental illness and mental retardation, as well as the homeless and economically disadvantaged, according to the agency.
